

Engineering Project: Build Your Own Tower of Babel

Using only paper cups, make your own Tower of Babel. Who can make the tallest and sturdiest? Take a photo of your tower and paste it in the space below:

Communication Confusion

Print this sheet out and cut out the communication confusion cards below. Assign a card to each person, giving the harder ones to the more able/older students. Photocopy the page entitled 'Say what?' and give each student one. It is now up to each student to convey the writing on the 'Say what?' card with the speech impediment on the 'Communication Confusion' card. Each card contains a Bible verse about the Tower of Babel and are numbered 1–6. They need to be communicated in that same order to make sense.

You may only mouth the words. If you whisper whilst mouthing you will be disqualified. The goal is to force the other students to lip read. You must not gesticulate in any way and should have your hands taped together.

You will only allowed to speak in Ob language. With this language you add the word Ob after the first letter of each word, finishing off the word as normal:

I want becomes lob wob ant.

You may only speak with a mouth impediment inside your mouth. You may choose between the Mouth Trap mouth guard or holding your tongue between your finger and thumb.

You may speak only using actions. No speaking, no prop usage, no drawing or writing. You may only use your own body, nothing else, to try to communicate your sentence.

You need to use cockney rhyming slang, where you replace one of the words in a sentence with a word that rhymes with it. So, with the sentence 'I don't believe it' could be 'I don't Adam and Eve it'

You are only allowed to communicate using drawings. Much like Pictionary, you mustn't write any words or gesticulate or point to anything. You are only allowed to use your drawings to communicate your sentence
