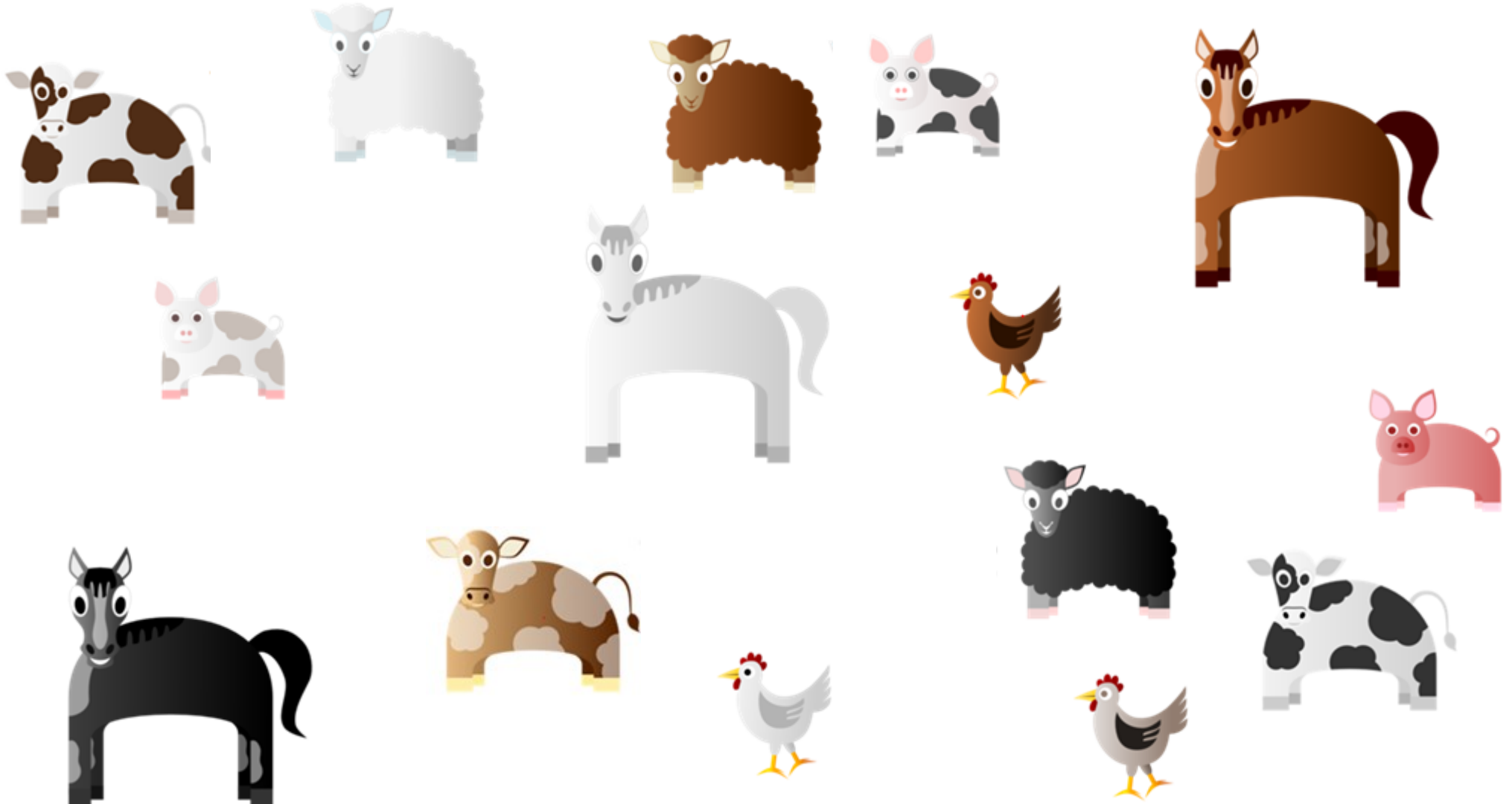




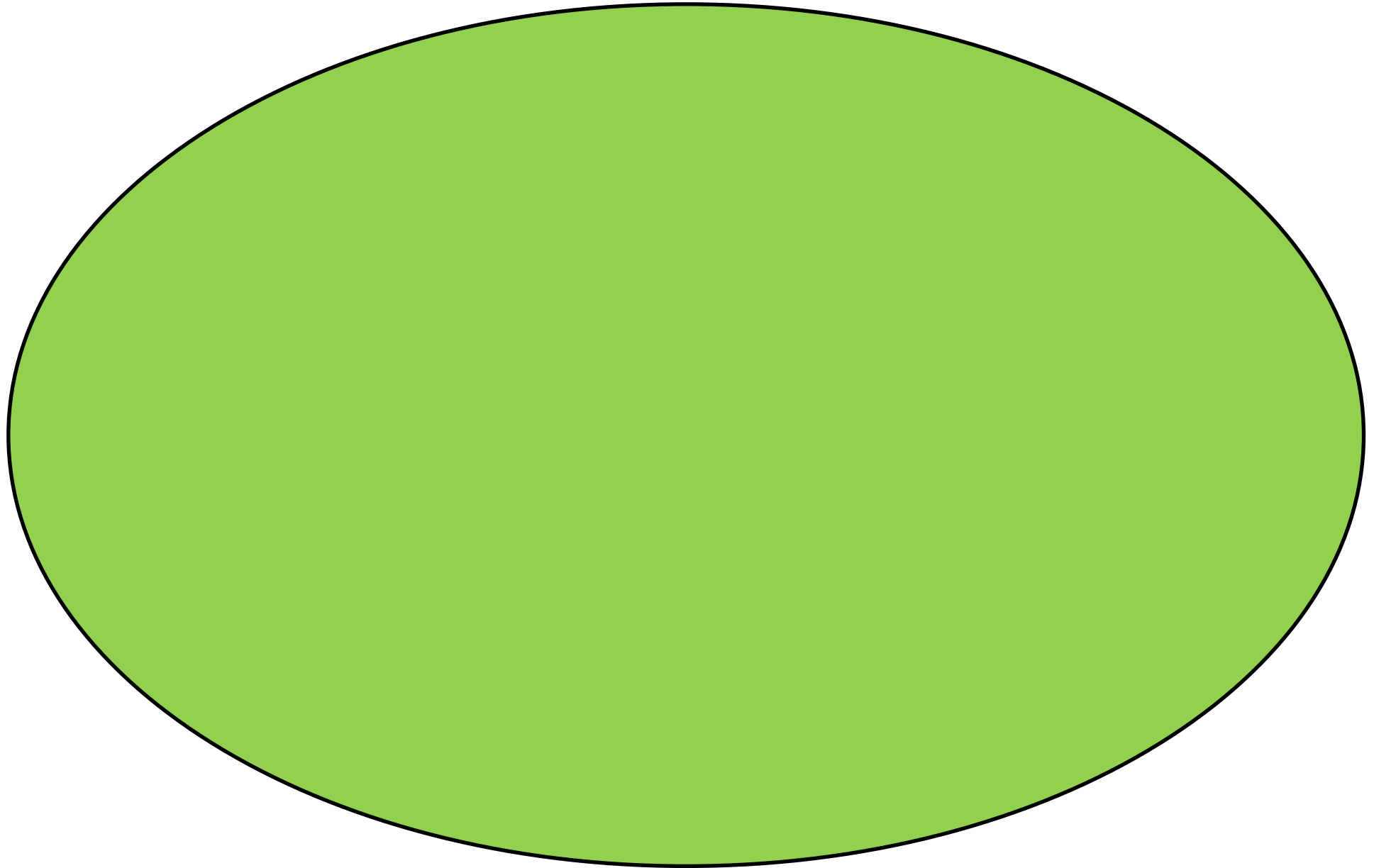
Print on card stock and cut out each animal

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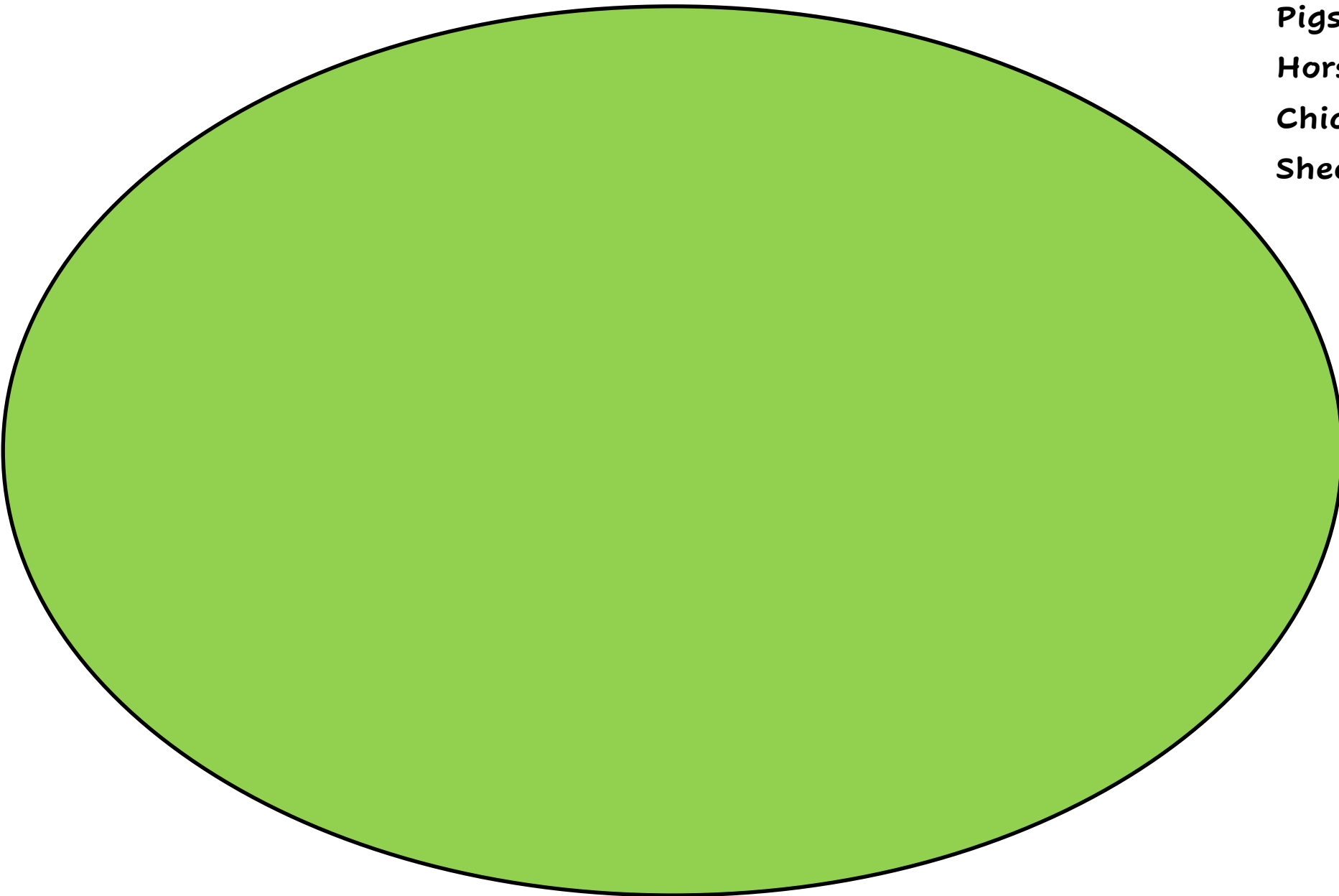
Mayhem has occurred at Buttercup Farm! Farmer Jack has woken up to chaos as every single one of his animals has escaped into the huge back field.

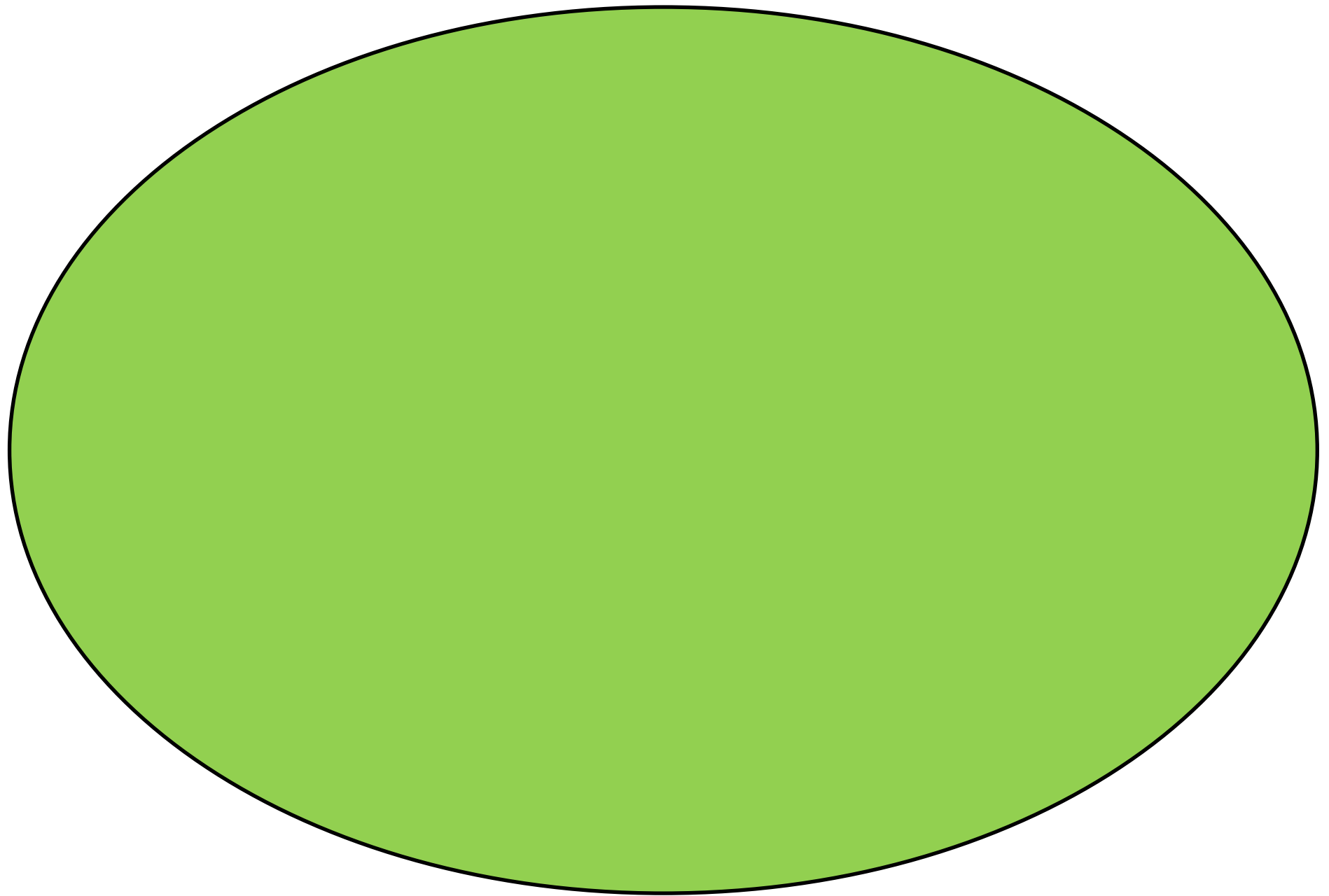


Using all the cut outs from the previous page, place like with like in groups (or sets). For example, you may choose to gather all the pigs into one set. Place each set into the circles below:

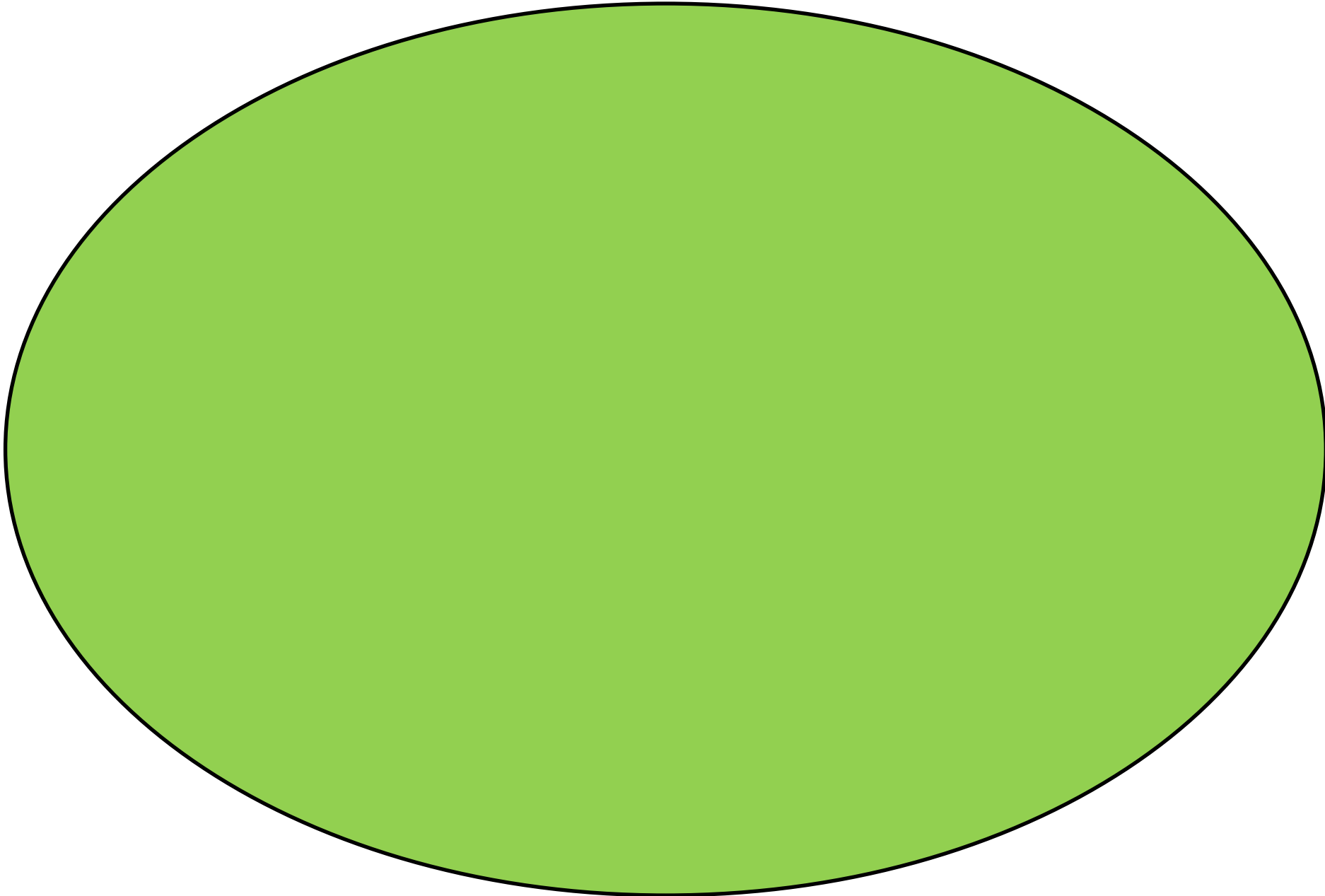

Sheep

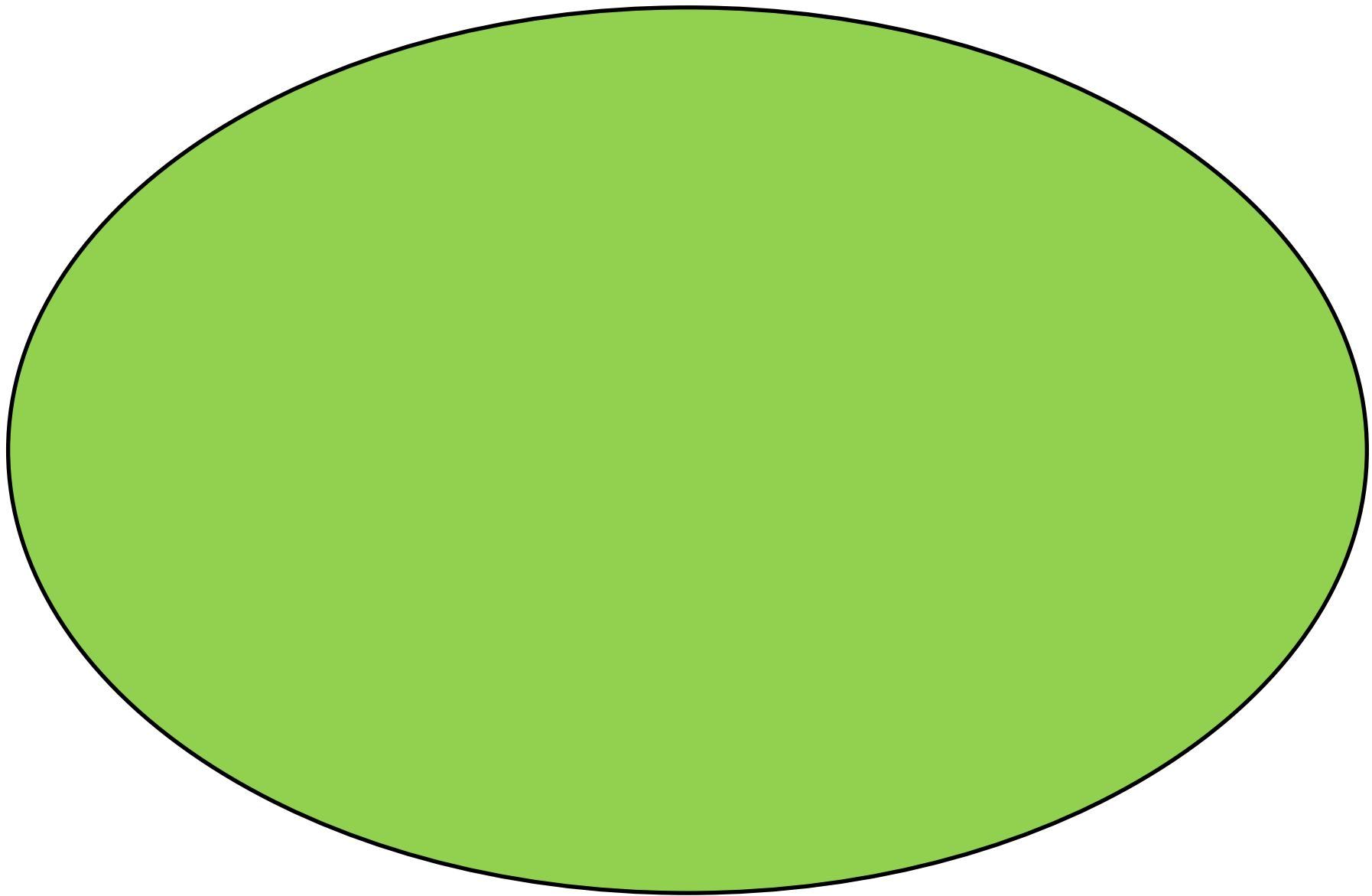

Beak

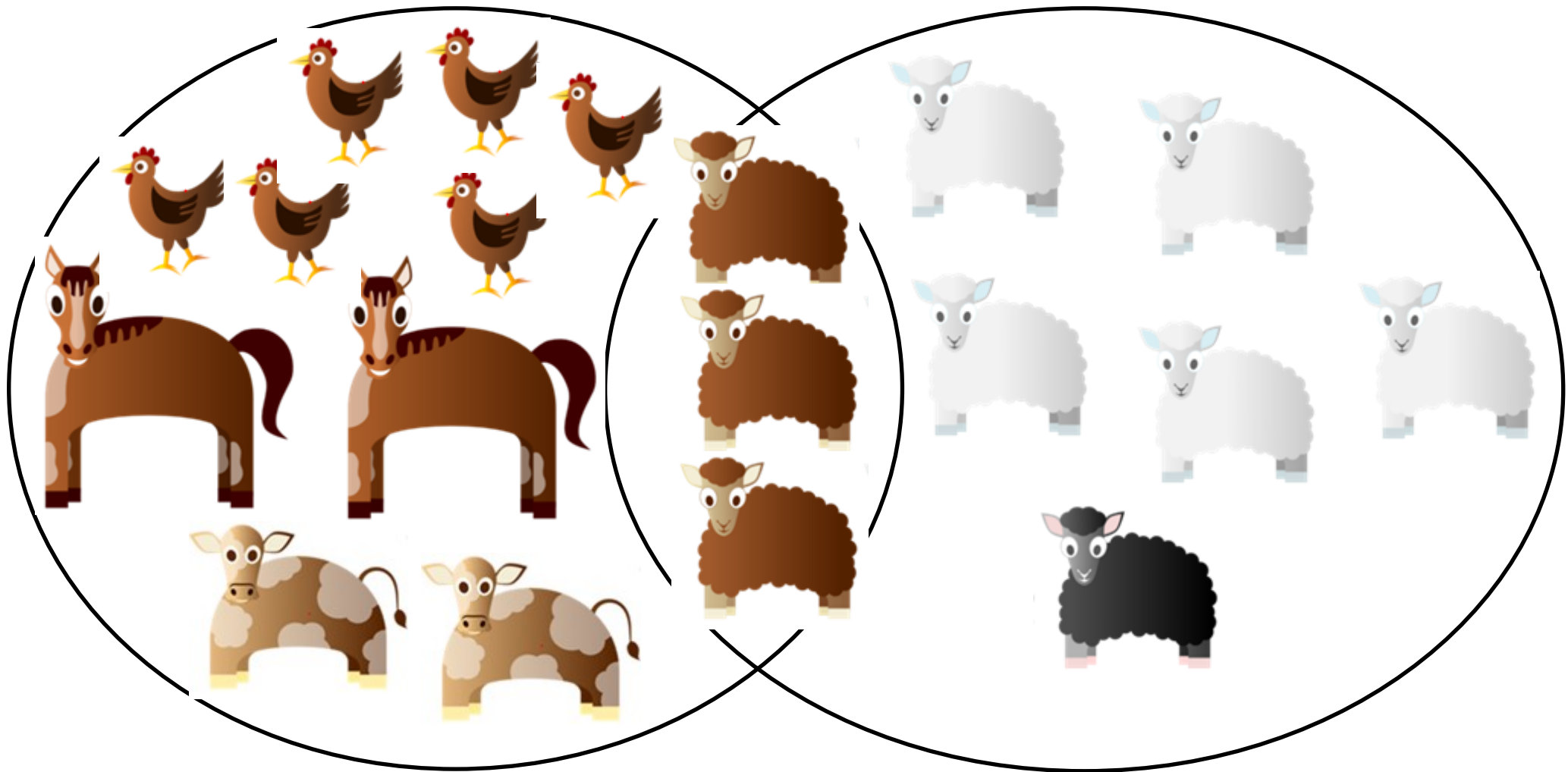
